**Rules and Guidelines:**

**1. Entry Fee**

- a) Stall fees** \$ 3 per foot (must include all tack and feed )
- b) Junior** entry fees of \$ 15 for 1<sup>st</sup> Animal and \$ 10 per additional animal
- c) Peewee** entry fees of \$ 10 for 1<sup>st</sup> Animal and \$ 5 per additional animal
- d) Participant herd** entry fee of \$20.00 must show yearling heifer, 2yr old cow-calf and mature cow-calf
- e) Competition skills** Judging, Grooming, Showmanship entry fees of \$5 per skill entered
- f) Marketing** No fee Participant must provide an item to be marketed in front of the judge and is then donated to the Holden Junior Cattlemen Show silent auction
- g) Team Judging** entry fee of \$5.00 per participant

- 2. Show is open to Junior's (Age 6 as of show date till 21 as of January 1, 2019).
- 3. Animals entered in the Peewee (Classes 100,200) are shown in these classes and do not compete against juniors.
- 4. Copy of the Registration papers must accompany entry for all purebred entries.
- 5. Tattoos on Purebred Animals must be legible.
- 6. The Show Committee and or its members are not responsible for accident or loss.
- 7. The show committee will have the ability to increase or decrease the length of the show as required to accommodate entry's received.
- 8. Livestock competing in competitions must be in the barns by 8:00 a.m. Saturday, June 27, 2019.
- 9. Livestock competing in conformation class on Sunday only and not participating in competition events must be in the Barn and ready to show by 8:00 am on Sunday.
- 10. All grooming, clipping, preparation and showing of animals must be done by the junior. In the case of young members (Peewee), older members will be requested to assist.  
**Adult/Parent participation is forbidden.**
- 11. All cattle must have a CCIA tag in their ear before arriving on the grounds. Any animal without CCIA tag will be disqualified, and asked to leave.
- 12. The use of steroids or any other means to enhance the growth or conformation of animals is strictly forbidden and will result in disqualification.
- 13. Unethical fitting of animals is FORBIDDEN and will result in disqualification.
- 14. Substitute entries will be permitted provided that they are within the same class.

Note: Any decisions made by the show committee will be final (disputes etc.)

**Class Descriptions:**

Peewee: for these classes (100) Heifer calf born 2019 or class (200) tame quiet yearling heifer the participants will compete in respective classes for ribbons with the top 2 from each class competing for grand champion or reserve champion banners

Female Classes: for each of these classes each class will compete in their respective classes for ribbons with the top 2 from each class moving on as follows

- Class (1100) and (1200) will compete for Grand champion or Reserve champion Junior Purebred Female Banners
- Class (1300) and (1400) will compete for Grand champion or Reserve champion Mature Purebred Female Banners
- Class (2100) and (2200) will compete for Grand champion or Reserve champion Junior Commercial Female Banners
- Class (2300) and (2400) will compete for Grand champion or Reserve champion Mature Commercial Female banners
- Feature breeds would follow same format provided the junior breed association provide a minimum of 20 animals to the show
- All Grand champion Junior Females will compete for Supreme Junior Female
- All Grand champion Mature Females will compete for Supreme Mature Female

**Male Classes:**

- For each of these Classes (6100, 6200 and 6300) each of these classes will compete for ribbons only.
- In the event a minimum of 15 entries are received in classes (6100 and 6200) combined then classes (6100) Bull calves and (6200) yearling Bulls will compete for Banners

**Herd Class**

- For this class participants will be able to highlight their herd and will compete for Grand champion and Reserve Champion Banners
- Participants must show a yearling heifer born in 2019 a 2yr. old cow born in 2018 with 2020 calf and a mature cow with a 2020 calf all must be from same home and enter ring at same time
- Adult participation will be allowed at discretion of show committee if not enough juniors are available to help.

### Confirmation Class Rules

#### Peewee

- The junior in these classes may only show in these classes.
- Only calendar calves may be shown in the Calendar Calf Class.
- If you have a tame yearling heifer you may show it in the Peewee yearling heifer class.
- Participants may have assistance from older juniors, but adult/parent assistance is strictly forbidden.
- Participants in these classes may show any animals available to them.

#### Purebred

- Purebred animal which must be registered with respective breed association.
- Animals must be tattooed
- Please have a photocopy of papers ready on request.
- Animal must be calm and manageable by Junior.

#### Commercial

- Commercial animal.
- Animal must be calm and manageable by Junior.

The decision of the Barn Boss/Directors shall be final. Any violation of rules may result in disqualification or a worse penalty.

Please keep the environment safe and positive for ALL participants and spectators.

### **Skills Competitions**

#### **Judging**

- Participants will compete in age categories

#### **Team Judging**

- Participants will compete in age category of oldest participant

#### **Grooming**

- Participants will compete in age categories

#### **Showmanship**

- Participants will compete in age categories

#### **Marketing**

- Participants will compete in age categories
- Participants provide an item they will market in front of a judge
- Item will then be donated to Holden Junior Cattle Show as silent auction item as a fund raiser to keep or show running
- Marketing class will be judged on creativity and sales pitch criteria for judging will be
  - creativity of the item 20 points
  - sales pitch introduction 5 points
    - Content (knowledge, messaging) 15 points
    - Close of sale 5 points
    - Answers questions from Judges 5 points
  - Confidence and overall impression 10 points
