Covid Policies & Procedures

There have been many changes this year to accommodate COVID-19 regulations in Alberta!

Please Note: Everyone must go through the COVID screening process and obtain a wristband before entering the building; this includes off-loading show animals. Please check in at the main doors before off-loading your trailer.

COVID screening is set up at the main entrance and is mandatory for anyone wishing to enter the building. The screening questions form is being included in this application; **please print one form per adult and bring the completed forms with you to the main entrance.**

Temperatures will be taken using a no-contact thermometer.

Wristbands are provided upon successful completion of the screening process to indicate compliance. Wristbands are required in order to enter the building.

Masks are mandatory, no exceptions. Masks will be available on site if you forget to bring one for yourself.

Failure to comply with any part of these regulations may result in your eviction from the event.

Rules and Guidelines:

1. **Entry Fee**
 - a) **Stall fees** \$ 3 per feet (must include all tack and feed)
 - b) **Junior** entry fees of \$ 15 for 1st Animal and \$ 10 per additional animal
 - c) **Peewee** entry fees of \$ 10 for 1st Animal and \$ 5 per additional animal
 - d) **Participant herd** entry fee of \$20.00 must show yearling heifer, 2yr old cow-calf and mature cow-calf, **Due to distancing requirements herd class will be judged while tied and participant there to answer Judges questions or show any animal as requested by the Judge.**
 - e) **Competition skills** Grooming, Showmanship entry fees of \$5 per skill entered

2. Show is open to Junior's (Age 6 as of show date till 21 as of January 1, 2021).
3. Animals entered in the Peewee (Classes 100,200,) are shown in these classes and do not compete against juniors.
4. Copy of the Registration papers must accompany entry for all purebred entries.
5. Tattoos on Purebred Animals must be legible.
6. The Show Committee and or its members are not responsible for accident or loss.
7. The show committee will have the ability to increase or decrease the length of the show as required to accommodate entry's received.
8. Livestock competing in competitions must be in the barns by 8:00 a.m. Saturday, June 26, 2021.
9. All grooming, clipping, preparation and showing of animals must be done by the junior. In the case of young members (Peewee), **Due to Covid to minimize contact and assist in distancing Adult/Parent participation will be permitted this year only.**
10. All cattle must have a CCIA tag in their ear before arriving on the grounds. Any animal without CCIA tag will be disqualified, and asked to leave.
11. The use of steroids or any other means to enhance the growth or conformation of animals is strictly forbidden and will result in disqualification.
12. Unethical fitting of animals is FORBIDDEN and will result in disqualification.
13. Substitute entries will be permitted provided that they are within the same class.

Note: Any decisions made by the show committee will be final (disputes etc.)

Class Descriptions:

Peewee: for these classes (100) Heifer calf born 2021 or class (200) tame quiet yearling heifer the participants will compete in respective classes for ribbons with the top 2 from each class competing for grand champion or reserve champion banners

Female Classes: for each of these classes each class will compete in their respective classes for ribbons with the top 2 from each class moving on as follows

- Class (1100) and (1200) will compete for Grand champion or Reserve champion Junior Purebred Female Banners
- Class (1300) and (1400) will compete for Grand champion or Reserve champion Mature Purebred Female Banners
- Class (2100) and (2200) will compete for Grand champion or Reserve champion Junior Commercial Female Banners
- Class (2300) and (2400) will compete for Grand champion or Reserve champion Mature Commercial Female banners
- All Grand champion Junior Females will compete for Supreme Junior Female
- All Grand champion Mature Females will compete for Supreme Mature Female

Male Classes:

- For each of these Classes (6100, 6200 and 6300) each of these classes will compete for ribbons only.
- In the event a minimum of 15 entries are received in classes (6100 and 6200) combined then classes (6100) Bull calves and (6200) yearling Bulls will compete for Banners

Herd Class

- For this class participants will be able to highlight their herd and will compete for Grand champion and Reserve Champion Banners
- Participants must show a yearling heifer born in 2020 a 2yr. old cow born in 2019 with 2021 calf and a mature cow with a 2021 calf all must be from same home and enter ring at same time

Confirmation Class Rules

Peewee

1. The junior in these classes may only show in these classes.
2. Only calendar calves may be shown in the Calendar Calf Class.
3. If you have a tame yearling heifer you may show it in the Peewee yearling heifer class.
4. Participants may have assistance from older juniors, **Due to distancing requirements parents will be permitted to assist this year only.**
5. Participants in these classes may show any animals available to them.

Purebred

1. Purebred animal which must be registered with respective breed association.
2. Animals must be tattooed
3. Please have a photocopy of papers ready on request.
4. Animal must be calm and manageable by Junior.

Commercial

1. Commercial animal.
2. Animal must be calm and manageable by Junior.

The decision of the Barn Boss/Directors shall be final. Any violation of rules may result in disqualification or a worse penalty.

Please keep the environment safe and positive for ALL participants and spectators.
