Rules and Guidelines:

1. **Entry Fee**
 - a) **Stall fees** are included in animal registration 4' per animal 6' per cow calf pair.
 - b) **Junior** entry fees of \$ 25 for 1st Animal and \$ 20 per additional animal
 - c) **Peewee** entry fees of \$ 20 for 1st Animal and \$ 15 per additional animal
 - d) **Participant herd** entry fee of \$20.00 must show yearling heifer, 2yr old cow-calf and mature cow-calf.
 - e) **Competition skills** Grooming, Showmanship entry fees of \$5 per skill entered

2. Show is open to Junior's (Age 6 as of show date Age 21 as of January 1, 2023).
3. Animals entered in the Peewee (Classes 100,5100,) are shown in these classes and do not compete against juniors. Participants may have assistance from older juniors.
4. The Show Committee and or its members are not responsible for accident or loss.
5. The show committee will have the ability to increase or decrease the length of the show as required to accommodate entries received.
6. Livestock competing in competitions must be in the barns by 8:00 a.m. Saturday, June 24, 2023.
7. All grooming, clipping, preparation and showing of animals must be done by the junior. In the case of young members (Peewee), older junior members may assist.
8. All cattle must have a CCIA tag in their ear before arriving on the grounds. Any animal without CCIA tag will be disqualified, and asked to leave.
9. The use of steroids or any other means to enhance the growth or conformation of animals is strictly forbidden and will result in disqualification.
10. Unethical fitting of animals is FORBIDDEN and will result in disqualification.
11. Substitute entries will be permitted provided that they are within the same class.

Note: Any decisions made by the show committee will be final (disputes etc.)

Class Descriptions:

Peewee: for these classes (100) Heifer calf born 2023, (5100) Bull calf born 2023, the participants will compete in respective classes for ribbons with the top from each class receiving PEE WEE banners.

Female Classes: for each of these classes each class will compete in their respective classes for ribbons with the top 2 from each class moving on as follows

- Class 2100 Champion and Reserve Female calf Prizes
- Class 2200 Champion and Reserve yearling Female Prizes
- Class 2300 Champion and Reserve 2yr old cow/calf Prizes
- Class 2400 Champion and Reserve mature cow/calf Prizes
- All Grand champion Females will compete for overall show Supreme Female and Reserve Supreme Female Prizes

Male Classes:

- For the Class (6200) Participants will compete for ribbons only.

Herd Class

- For this class participants will be able to highlight their herd and will compete for Grand champion and Reserve Champion Banners
- Participants must show a yearling heifer born in 2022 a 2yr. old cow born in 2021 with 2023 calf and a mature cow with a 2023 calf all must be from same home and enter ring at same time

The decision of the Barn Boss/Directors shall be final. Any violation of rules may result in disqualification or a worse penalty.
